

Reclaimed Eastern White Pine is a softer wood with coloration ranging from a light blonde to deep chestnut tones. Our Rustic White Pine flooring is typically darker than Pumpkin Pine, with more checking, nail holes, and knots, presenting diverse visual elements of character and use.

Virgin white pine has been aggressively harvested since the colonial era, when the British Royal Navy infamously requisitioned particularly fine specimens for use as masts. Today, white pine is farmed and sawn for lumber as quickly as possible, making it entirely different than product milled from our reclaimed old-growth timber.



Standard Dimensions

4"- 14" wide planks (*wider upon special order*)
2' to 14' lengths
3/4" thick
Tongue-and-groove and end-matched.

Grain

Straight, with typical old-growth irregularities. Mixed flat and quartersawn.

Color

Ranges from white/blonde and fine golden color to brown with occasional reddish hue.

Character

Knots, nail holes, checking, and mineral stains are incorporated into this grade.

Hardness & Stability

A soft and stable wood. 380lb_f on the Janka hardness scale. ~1.56 pounds per square foot.
