

Reclaimed Hickory



Hickory is a classic American wood, popularly associated with barbecued or smoked meats, golf clubs, and tool handles. Reclaimed antique hickory flooring channels this diversity in application through its high-contrast coloration and classic patterning.

Hickory floor planks can range in color from light vanilla to dark chocolate – sometimes in a single board. Knots, occasional nail holes, light surface checking, and possible worm tracks provide this wood with inimitable ‘tough’ characteristics.

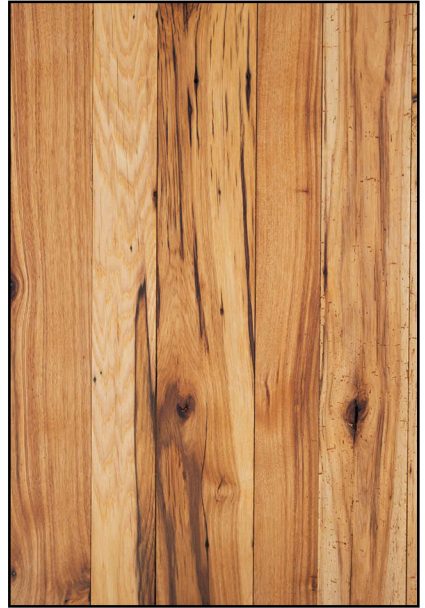
Standard Dimensions

2.5” - 8.5” wide planks (*wider w/ speical order*)

2’ to 12’ lengths

3/4” thick

Tongue-and-groove and end-matched.



Grain

Straight, occasionally wavy, with typical old-growth irregularities. Mixed flat and quartersawn.

Color

Ranges from whitish-cream to light/medium brown, can feature dark brown/black streaks.

Character

Knots occur. Small nail holes and checking may be present, along with slight mineral staining.

Hardness & Stability

An extremely hard and relatively stable flooring. 1,880lb_f on the Janka hardness scale. ~3.12 pounds per square foot.
