

A more rustic alternative to our bright-planed spruce, skip-planed spruce flooring possesses the same old-growth qualities, with added character from original band and circular saw marks.

Skip-planed spruce flooring maintains the formality of traditional old-growth softwood flooring, with more contrast in color, tone, and character.

Although the hardness of this wood matches bright-planed spruce, the skip-planed texture means this floor shows wear at a reduced rate.

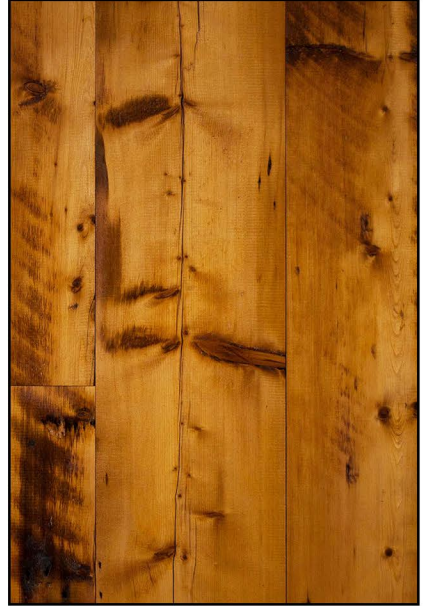
## Standard Dimensions

4" - 10" wide planks (*wider upon special order*)

4' to 14' lengths

3/4" thick

Tongue-and-groove and end-matched.



## Grain

Straight, with typical old-growth irregularities. Mixed flat and quartersawn.

## Color

Planed surface is creamy white, with hints of yellow and/or red. Knots are medium to dark brown. Skipped surface is medium-brown to black.

## Character

Original circular and bandsaw markings, old-growth knots, some checking, nail holes, and some mineral staining are present and desirable.

## Hardness & Stability

A soft and stable wood. ~467lb<sub>f</sub> on the Janka hardness scale. ~1.67 pounds per square foot.



## Certifications

Qualifies for LEED MRc3, Materials Reuse credit. May qualify for LEED MRc5, Regional Materials credit.
